Our program, Express STEPs, is a solid foundational skills program with room for growth. To that end, the entire curriculum is housed on the digital <u>Teacher's Platform</u> so as we learn more we can be responsive to the research. Programs need to shift as our knowledge base strengthens and expands, and although reviews and adoptions don't necessarily allow for this type of change, we think it is incredibly important to stay up-to-date with what we know best. To that end, Express STEPs will continue to be modified, and notifications will be added to help teachers know when such changes have been made.

The first change that will come this year, in 2024, is a clearer alignment between our phonics scope and sequence and the Daily Dos (phonological/phonemic awareness

strand). The Daily Dos were created, to show letters and utilize graphics to incorporate vocabulary acquisition, to provide a daily structure of phonemic awareness (along with various other phonological awareness skills, such as rhyming and syllable work). These Daily Dos were built to make the practice engaging, for easy-to-follow lessons for teachers, and to remove prep needed to create vibrant visuals and daily usage. Further connection between phonics being taught will increase the effectiveness of the practices, and we look forward to providing that for our teachers and students.

<u>The Teacher's Platform</u> not only contains our program, Express STEPS, as well as hundreds of supplemental activities to help teachers find valuable educational practice and games to assist review, further practice to mastery, and skill-level support.

Since the program began as a passion-driven project to support our resources, it will remain loyal to that view. We will be providing the entire Teacher's Platform teacher who needs access to an affordable, quality foundational skills curriculum and assessment program. We want structured literacy to be available to any teacher or school who needs it, because every student needs explicit and systematic instruction and practice.

Teacher knowledge is the most essential part of the success of our students, and so our hope is that educational establishments will provide opportunities for teacher growth before the retention of programs. BUT, teachers need tools and resources to effectively provide for their students, and our company hopes to help in any way that makes that possible.
